

At the online conference on consumer policy in the digital age, organized by the German Federal Ministry of Justice and Consumer Protection in cooperation with the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) – supported by Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) we will examine how to ensure digital self-determination for consumers as well as access to justice and enforcement options. 
The registration form is available in English and German language.

To avoid interference (i.e. "zoombombing"), the link and token should be shared restrictively.




Access is available for registered participants who have received a "token" from the organizers to log in.

The livestream will only be available for the duration of the event.



The event will be held over Zoom (for speakers) and livestreamed with slight delay on a customized platform.

This platform has common features to enable audience interaction, such as a Q&A/chat function and polling.



Speakers and presentations will be "spotlighted" by the technical team (behind the scenes, operating via Zoom).

The following screenshots illustrate what this then looks like for the audience viewing the livestream.





Speaker with name and designation appears with banderole at the bottom – and if needed, alongside their presentations or other panelists.

Speakers are either joining from the studio or remotely from their respective locations.
