THE PURPOSE

To increase the level of consumer confidence in online transaction by providing a holistic protection and ultimately boost the growth of electronic commerce in Malaysia.



- Online Traders who operate businesses for supply of goods or services through websites (webpages,blogs,socialmedias) or in online marketplaces (e.g. lelong.my, ebay); and
- Online Marketplace Operators.

- The online trader's name (individual / business / company).
- The business or company registration number.
- The online trader's e-mail address and telephone number or address.
- The description of the main characteristics of the goods/ services.
- The full price of the goods / services including transportation costs, taxes and any other costs.
- The methods of payment.
- · The terms and conditions.
- The estimated delivery time of goods / services to the buyer.



- **2. Must provide the appropriate means** to enable the buyers to **rectify any errors** prior to the buyers' confirmation of the orders.
- **3. Must acknowledge receipts of the orders** to the **buyers** without undue delay.

ONLINE MARKETPLACE OPERATORS:



To keep and to maintain the records of the names, telephone numbers and addresses of their online traders for the period of two years.



No.	Offences	Individual	Body Corporate
	First offence	Fine maximum of RM 50,000 or jail for a maximum term of 3 years or both.	Fine maximum of RM 100,000.
2.	Second or subsequent offence	Fine maximum of RM 100,000 or jail for a maximum term of 5 years or both.	Fine maximum of RM 200,000.
3.	Continuing offence	Fine maximum of RM 1,000 for each day or part of a day during which the offence continues after conviction.	
4.	Compound	Not exceeding 50% of the amount of maximum fine for that offence.
